BUNBURY Classes run Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday between 9.00am – 2.30pm for approximately 28 weeks, excluding school and public holidays. Work placement will be negotiated between students and their host employer to determine duration.

Where

Classes are held in a convenient location close to public transport and with adequate parking.

Cost

The WA government requires students to make a contribution towards subsidised courses. Please contact us directly to discuss your circumstances as concession rates are available, as well as payment plans and fee waiver for people experiencing financial hardship.
