

KidSport enables eligible Western Australian children aged 5 to 18 years to participate in community sport and recreation by offering them financial assistance of up to \$200 per calendar year towards club fees.

Who is eligible for KidSport?

All Western Australian children aged 5 to 18 with a valid Health Care Card or Pensioner Concession Card are eligible for KidSport.

How does KidSport work?

Currently KidSport can be <u>applied for online</u> or by using a hard copy application form. Parents can apply through the online application on the Department of Sport and Recreation website https://www.dsr.wa.gov.au/funding/individuals/kidsport and receive up to \$200 per child per calendar year. The application is a very simple online process which assures confidentiality.

KidSport applications are assessed by the local government in which the child resides. If an application is approved, the parents will receive a code (unique to the application) via email. The code needs to be provided to the club so that the approved amount can be deducted from the registration fees.
