Now available online

The new-look School Curriculum and Standards Authority student portal is live. You can now download digital copies of the documents in your folio of achievement. Simply log in and follow the prompts.

Get your certificates in three easy steps

Log in to the student portal at <https://studentportal.scsa.wa.edu.au>

You will need your WA student number, which has eight digits and can be found on the documents in your folio of achievement, examination timetable or 2018 SmartRider.

Your default password has been reset to **Nnddmmyyy**, where Nn is the first two letters of your family name: first as upper case, second as lower case, followed by your date of birth in day month year format.

You can view and download digital copies of the following certificates:

- Western Australian Certificate of Education (WACE)
- Western Australian Statement of Student Achievement (WASSA)
- ATAR course reports
- Awards

Present digital copies of your WACE, WASSA, ATAR course reports and awards when applying for university, TAFE, employment or training.
